We made it through another year of shows! In spite of several setbacks, these shows were very nice & we received some great compliments! Thank you to each of you instrumental in helping make these shows successful! Even the weatherman was nice to us, giving us sunshine without too much heat, & just a light breeze at the end of the day instead of 50 mph winds.

Battleborn Blade Sharpening donated a pair of shears at the end of the shows last year. We decided to hold an armband drawing to give them away this year. Before we had the drawing on Sunday, he donated a pair of scissors, so we added them to the drawing & two exhibitors left happy, one with a pair of scissors, the other with a pair of shears! Battleborn told me that they will donate another pair to give away next year.

We had a couple volunteers step in to ring steward for Obedience & Rally. They were both exhibitors, helping in between showing. To assist them, a 4H member came on Saturday. We also recruited ROTC Cadets. The experienced ring stewards (exhibitors) were extremely happy with the help that ROTC offered & said they would be great for us to use in the future.

I had a good opportunity to discuss park issues with the Mayor as we waited for Best In Show. An exhibitor I met earlier that day came & talked with her, telling her how wonderful the park is & how great the area is. This exhibitor had talked to me & told me how wonderful our trophies were. He said he travels the nation for dog shows & had never been to a show that does what we do for our exhibitors. He commented that not only did we provide the quantity of trophies that we offer, they were quality trophies, not just "cheap" items. He was thrilled our catalogs are just \$5, he loved the park, he told me that in his opinion, we have the potential to become "a premier dog show on the West Coast." He said he would write a letter. I'm hoping he will so I can share it with the Mayor to show what exhibitors think of our area. The Mayor asked where everyone comes from. I told her I would have statistics after the show in the information that we receive & will share it with her. On Sunday, another City Supervisor came at my request to observe the show & what we do. He is someone I went to high school with. We were able to talk for a little bit as well. He also asked for the statistics that the Mayor wants. I am working on that information for them now.

Dennis Johnson was **THRILLED** at the retirement gift of a silver dollar money clip that the club presented to him.

### General Meeting Minutes

September 6, 2022

Meeting called to order by President Candy Roper at 7:09 p.m.

Motion Carolyn Goepner, second Elaine Oxborrow, to approve the August minutes as printed in the August newsletter. Motion passed unanimously.

**Secretary reports:** None

**Treasurer report:**

Lexine Thompson reported the beginning balance was \$31,731.42 with income of \$254.48 for trophy donations and match entries, with expenses of \$295.40 for telephone, trophies, website, and judges lodging, for an ending balance of \$31,690.50.

**Committees**

**Show Committee:**

Candy reported our Obedience Judge resigned because of a family emergency, but we were able to find another judge. We may have a larger Obedience and Rally entry due to a Bay Area club that has moved their date. They are usually the same weekend as us. There was a problem with their venue. They intend to go back to their original date next year.

Entries for our shows close next Wednesday, September 14<sup>th</sup> so don't forget to enter.

Elaine Oxborrow, Lexine, and Candy did a walk through at Fuji Park with the Parks Department a couple weeks ago. Rick Berger asked if we can use our stakes for the canopies. Lexine said there was a misunderstanding in the way the question was asked previously. They have no problem with using small stakes that aren't liable to damage the water lines. Because the premium list states no stakes allowed, we will just not enforce exhibitors using stakes.

Candy asked Elaine about the electrical. Elaine said because of everything going on that weekend, United Rentals doesn't have anything available. The people Elaine had do the electrical for RV parking last year can do it again, but the boxes where vendors and reserved grooming are will be a problem. Bruce Rettick came up on Saturday and walked the park with Elaine. He had some good ideas including needing to raise our RV parking next year. We can offer more electricity if we raise parking. Elaine didn't realize we could have more electricity along the east and west side. The person Elaine knows can supply the tails if we get the twist connectors for the boxes. There are some on Amazon for under \$30.00/each. We will need approximately 13. Elaine can tie them into his tails and we will have power. We will get our connectors back after the shows. Elaine ordered one to see if it fits. If it works, then she would like permission from the club to order the remaining 12 so we will have them for the future. The Parks Department is not going to help with electrical anymore. She will try to get an order to United Rentals in January in order to get what we need for next year.

Elaine isn't sure how Bob Kinney will monitor the paid grooming area. Thea Tsurumoto suggested wrist bands. How will we police it? We don't have enough people to watch the area. Candy said we should probably not offer it in the future. Elaine said if we raise parking we should be able to expand the RV parking to the west side and offer electrical. Elaine asked for permission to go ahead and order the connectors.

Elaine is waiting for a quote to rent a PA system because we don't have any safe way to hang our speakers. Last year we had issues because people couldn't hear the system. It is very antiquated so Elaine will see if she can rent from someone she knows. We may want to look into getting our own system. Rick said it depends where you put the speakers. Elaine said these go on tripods and can go anywhere.

Motion Lexine Thompson, second Yvonne Roscoe, to buy 13 connectors for approximately \$360.00 for electrical. Motion passed unanimously.

The cost of Fuji Park has gone from about \$3,500 to \$6,500 this year. When Candy and Lexine received the invoice, the amount appeared to be the same. Somehow they missed that the cost is per day, not for the weekend as it has been in the past. This will be a very tough year financially. Candy thought by cancelling the arena for Thursday and Sunday we could save money. However, because we use the RV area, we have to pay for the arena to have access to the RV area. Elaine asked if we really want a PA system. We really do need to have it. Elaine is hoping for a really good discount because the person has been friends with her for a long time.

Candy said we still need a golf cart. Kathie Peterson's is broken so Candy put out a request to friends to see if anyone had one we could use. Lisa Hamilton may know someone that has one we can use. The golf cart stays in the Park and is locked in the building at night. Lisa will ask.

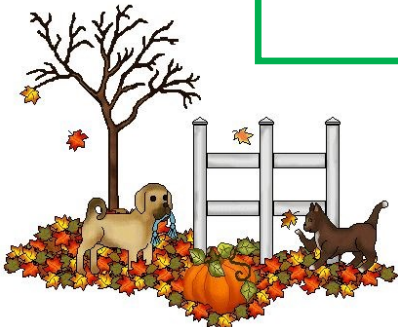
