General Meeting Minutes ~ September 5, 2023

Meeting was called to order by President Candy Roper at 7:02 p.m.

Cindra Smith said there was a correction to the minutes for August 1, 2023. She didn't talk to John Potter but contacted him by a form on the website.

Motion by Elaine Oxborrow, second Marian Panter, to approve the August minutes as amended. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer report:

Lexine Thompson reported the beginning balance was \$32,095.63 with income of \$100.00 for trophy donation and expenses of \$3,336.91 for trophies, show supplies, rent for the fall show, telephone and website, for an ending balance of \$28,858.72.

Lexine asked Elaine Oxborrow if she had contacted her IRS friend regarding the 501(c)3. She said not yet.

Committees:

Show Committee:

Candy has ordered all the rosettes for Pee Wee, ACT, and New Title holders as well as books for the Pee Wee's.

Candy is working on the ring stewards. The Stewards Association is working on the conformation stewards and Truckee Meadows Dog Training Club should have 6 stewards for us this year. Two are new to stewarding and two are experts. The two experts will be there all day both days. Candy let them know last year the stewards used the ROTC for help with obedience and rally. ROTC is lined up and coming.

Judges rooms are reserved at Gold Dust. The National Anthem is covered both days by the same lady as last year-Stevielynn Webber. Ring equipment on Friday will be available for the specialties.

The morning of the shows, we need someone to pick up donuts both mornings. Cindra Smith said she will pick them up between 6:00-6:15.

We have a donated golf cart from Eagle Valley Golf Course but we need someone to pick it up Thursday morning and return probably Monday morning.

Thea Tsurumoto mentioned the arena needs the ground to be soft. Lexine said John (Doran, Parks Department) said he would go 5-6" deep. Candy will ask them to do the arena on Wednesday and ask him to disk and drag but not to pack it down.

Candy said we have insurance for all three days for Bonanza Kennel Club but we need to know if it covers other events and clubs. Lexine will ask the insurance company. It may be an issue for specialties in the future because the park is rented in our name. Carolyn Goepner said for her specialty they put Parks on the policy with her name.

Elaine Oxborrow will do treat for exhibitors again like last year. Candy said that Lisa Hamilton will be there Thursday and Friday to help with set-up, and Saturday to help with Pee Wees. Hilary Arnaud may also help.

Candy reminded the club nothing can be left at the show site overnight Sunday. Elaine Oxborrow said the electrical may not be picked up until Monday. Elaine will double check to see if they can get the electrical on Sunday. Parks was not happy we left things in the building on Sunday night last year.

Candy thanked Carolyn Goepner, Nancy Hurwitz, Cindra Smith, Rick Berger, Thea Tsurumoto, and Marian Panter. They had a trailer workday to clean up and organize the club trailer. She said we need someone to oversee the trailer on Sunday after the shows to make sure the club trailer gets loaded correctly. There are pictures of the finished clean-up to compare. There are enough small ring coolers in the trailer.




