# SOLDIER ADOPTS WAR DOG WHO SAVED HIS LIFE

In Afghanistan, Layka was there for her handler Staff Sgt. Julian McDonald when it mattered most.

After being released into a building, she took four gunshots, but still managed to attack the shooter, saving all the servicemen on the mission.

When McDonald returned to the United States, he proved his loyalty to the bomb-sniffing dog who saved his life by welcoming her into his family. This month, Layka was featured on the front cover of *National Geographic* magazine with the headline Hero Dogs. Although she was trained to be a viscious fighter, she proved to be gentle and patient with the McDonald family, including their toddler son. "If you bring them into a home environment, they will become a product of that environment," McDonald said.

Lakya had her front leg amputated after the shooting but still romps around the yard as though nothing ever happened.

"If the dog's put the time into the country, then the country owes it them to put the time into them," he said. "I have a lot of respect for [the war dogs.] They do stuff I wouldn't want to do. I know they do stuff 99% of America wouldn't want to do. ... Our hats go off to them."
