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## **GENERAL MINUTES OF OCTOBER 6, 2015**

**Meeting called to order by President Candy Roper at 7:04 pm.**

**Minutes printed in the Newsletter of September 2015, motion to approve as printed Vice President Sieg Goepner 2<sup>nd</sup> by Board member Cindy Craig, motion passed.**

**Recording Secretary: NO report**

**Corresponding Secretary: Gail Spieker received thank you cards from Judges Linda Reidel, Marcie Dobkin, and President Candy Roper from Karen Ericson, and Bill Edwards. Paws for Veterans, Allison Southard, thanking us for our support. Board Member Cindy Craig received a thank you from the Border Collie group complimenting us for a great match. She also included that the Bulldog people were extremely happy with their match. They received 30-35 entries. Our match had only 10 entries. Cindy requested if we could do a Reserve Best in Match. Our match did have a breed represented in every group.**

**Treasurer Report: Bob Newman, Dog Show expenses: Parking \$895.00, Judges fees \$8,955.00, Judges rooms \$1,796.26, Hospitality \$1,159.79, Rent of grounds \$2,970.37. Total show costs \$15,777.12. Income: Parking \$3,330.00, Entries \$17,446.19 total income \$20,776.19 our Net:\$4999.78. Beginning Balance \$25,069.73 plus net from show \$4999.78 Balance ending \$30,069.51**

**Old Business: President Candy Roper announced that the IRS did not allow for our changing of the fiscal year. Our accountant Strong McPhearson is working on it. She also announced that there were no major issues during our show. There was a loose dog in the parking lot. It was suggested that the park department be notified and close the dog park in the future for 48 hours during our show. They do close the dog park during the state fair. She said it was suggested to have for the following year (2016) to include Award of Merits for the supported entries at the all breed shows. A discussion followed no motion on subject. We did have a minor issue with raffle tables by other clubs. It was agreed to let the specialty clubs have their raffle tables on Friday only. Belgian Sheepdogs want a Friday Specialty show and will support the all breed shows for 2016. A invitation letter will need to be sent to them. The Bulldog, Rottweiler, Belgian Tervuren, Rottweiler, German Shorthair Pointers, and Papillons Clubs want to do a supported entry for 2016 as well. Boston Terrier group expressed an interest in having a supported entry for our all breed Shows in 2016. Carolyn Geopner suggested to check with all the Specialty clubs if they are bringing their own ribbons. Contract for 2016 is ready to be sign with MB-F. Obedience Judge Tim Peterson donated his fee of \$24.00 to the local 4-H club or other charity we see fit.. Board Member Cindy Craig to follow up. Our Saturday Best in Show winner Jean Hargis decided not to return the silver dollars in exchange for a check. Corresponding Secretary Gail Spieker asked how many silver dollars do we have left. It was suggested that the treasurer locate more silver dollars for our Best In Show trophies. Member Carolyn Goepner expressed her opinion that the entries could have been down due to the closing date of our show following labor day weekend, that we should not have a problem next year as our show will be October 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016**

**Vice President Sieg Goepner (Grounds Chairman) thanked everyone for working as a team and that he felt it was the nicest show we have had and thanked the stewards for a job well done.**

## **Continuation of General Minutes of October 6th, 2015**

President Candy also agreed and thanked everyone for pitching in. Vice President Sieg Goepner commented on the kitchen hospitality for a super job, he made a motioned to pay the Kitchen staff \$200.00 as a thank you Recording Secretary Judy Davis 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion, motion passed.

**New Business:** President Candy Roper announced we need to appoint the nominating committee, Recording Secretary Judy Davis, volunteer, The board appointed Ann Kinney and Tony Yarbrough as members with Cindy Craig and Lynn McLellan as alternates. Report is to be back to the board by October 15<sup>th</sup>. Nomination from the floor will be held at our November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2015. There will be no December meeting.
