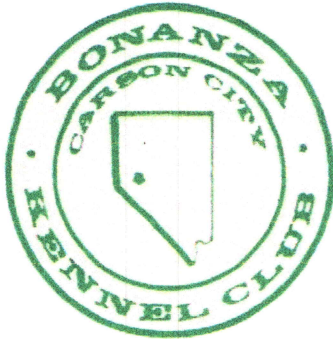

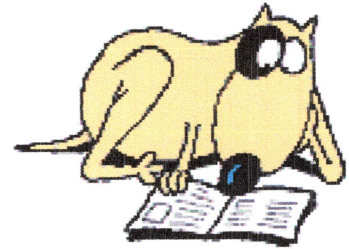

President's Message

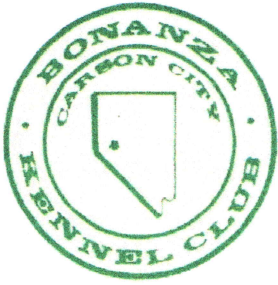

SECTION 2. Officers:

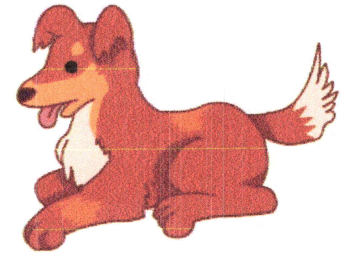
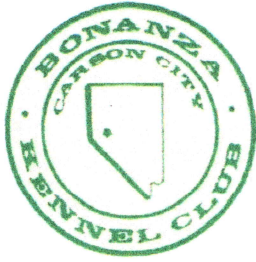
- g) The offices of both Secretary positions or either Secretary position and Treasurer may be held by the same person, in which case the board shall be comprised of (6) persons.”

REVISED General Meeting Minutes

January 8, 2019

Meeting was called to order by President Candy Roper at 7:05 p.m.

Motion made by Sieg Goepner to accept the minutes as printed in the November 2018 newsletter; second by Nancy Hurwitz. Motion passed unanimously.

Secretary reports: None

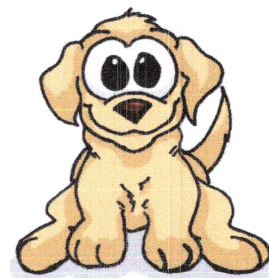
Treasurer report: Lexine Thompson reported beginning balance \$29,310.81. Expenses were \$1,491.46 for yearly insurance, Jack's Travel for remaining judges travel, phone November 2018-March 2019. Income was \$379.62 for dues, donation from Cook Photography and reimbursement for damage done by an exhibitor at the show for an ending balance of \$28,198.97.

Committees

Show: Candy and Rick said there really isn't any news regarding the 2019 show.

Sieg said his meeting with Carson City Parks & Recreation was postponed.

It's not too soon to let us know if you want to sponsor a trophy this fall. If you want to sponsor a Group 1, we offer a \$25 VISA gift card each day. If you have the Trophy Chairman pick the gift card up for you, you will also need to cover the card fee. If you want to sponsor a breed, let Carolyn know what you will be offering. This information has to be in the premium, which is due this spring.



Sunshine Committee: Carolyn sent out some cards to members.

Candy mentioned that Lynn McLellan lost her husband Robert. Lynn said not necessary to do any donations.

Candy said that Gail is doing better but because of weather was not able to come to the meeting.

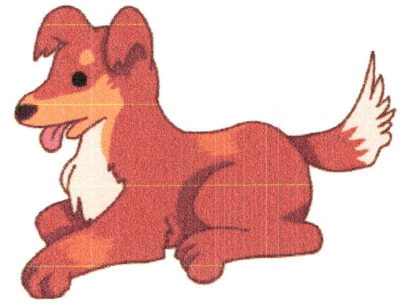

New Business: Judy Davis made a motion to have Owner Handler Series at the Bonanza club show this year. Susanne Haug mentioned the Owner Handler allows owner handlers to get the opportunity to go into groups. Candy asked Rick judges opinions on Owner Handler. Judges do not get extra money and there are some that don't want to do Owner Handler.

Rick disagrees that we would get more entries if we offered Owner Handler. Rick has judged OH and said it depends on the show if it increases entries. Having OH also brings up the issue of stewarding. Without good stewards, OH can be a nightmare. We did well with our stewards last year, but they are not ready for OH. Judges need good stewards to help with the OH series as it can be confusing. We are not ready yet to add OH. We have been gathering information and looking at whether or not we can add it.

Cindy said there are certain breeds that want OH at shows. Bob Kinney mentioned judges are already set for 2019 show and it would be difficult to change as new contracts would need to be done.

Lexine said we are one of the last shows for OH stats so that may be a draw.

Shawn said that we need to plan ahead. We don't really have the resources yet but might be possible in two years. Bonanza is known for putting on a quality show and we don't want to jeopardize that by pushing too fast to add it.

It has been discussed but there are many things that need to be looked at. Candy mentioned if we add it, we could look at having it one day only to see how it goes. It was decided that it will be tabled for 2019 but we will revisit it. Motion failed due to lack of a second.

Rick said he is still not sure if we could be ready in 2020. Elaine Bergenheier asked if Rick knows which judges would do OH and he wasn't sure.

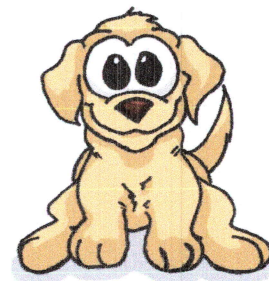
Dee asked if there would be more stewarding classes and Candy said yes we will work on it.

Reno Kennel Club offers OH on both days. Vikki said it brings in more entries. At a cluster back East it increased the entries by 300 additional entries. Rick isn't sure it would do that here.

Motion Judy Davis and second Vikki Jaramillo to have OH at the 2020 show. Those in favor – 11 Those in opposition – 12. Motion failed.

Candy said this has been discussed with the superintendent to get more information. We will continue to pursue OH at future shows.

Standing Rules were read by Lexine.



Candy said that it should be in the Standing Rules that if the January meeting falls on New Year's Day it will be held the second Tuesday.

Also, if prospective members are voted in after August 31st that they will not need to pay dues for the next year. If you are voted in as a member in the last calendar quarter you do not owe dues for the following year. Motion made by Sharon White to accept the two proposals and seconded by Carolyn. The motion passed unanimously. There will be new Standing Rules printed and updated on the website.

Shawn said that the Tervuren club will not offer Obedience on Friday at the Bonanza show.

Carolyn made a motion to adjourn at 8:00 p.m.

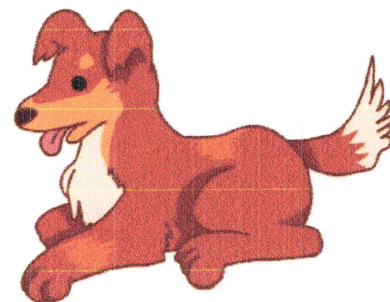

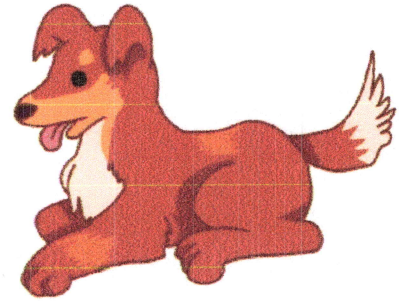
