Secretary reports:

Gail reported that AKC sent an email regarding the Dog Museum asking for money to help build the museum in New York City near Grand Central Station. She will forward the email to be included in the newsletter.

Bob Newman resigned as treasurer after over twenty years. The board appointed Lexine Thompson until the next election. It was agreed it was a good replacement. There was no activity so the balance was the same as last month. If there are any changes, the information will be at the next meeting at Fuji Park July 7th.

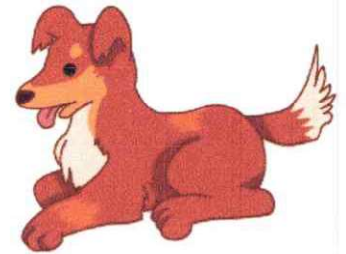
Committees

Stewarding: There will be a stewarding class on July 7th at Fuji park instead of a match. Bob Kinney will do class starting at 10:00 a.m. Candy will put it on the facebook page and website as well as send out emails to all the dog clubs. It will be at the gazebo. There are tables that will be set up as rings for training. We not only need people to learn stewarding but we also need bodies to be exhibitors. Ann has stewarding books that are like catalog/judge books that she will make copies for the class. Sieg also has AKC stewarding guidelines he will bring.

Show: Candy has nothing new for the show. Premium is at the printer for first proof and should take a couple of weeks to get back. Rick has nothing new other than we are starting to hire judges for 2019 show and sending out contracts. We don't have obedience or rally judges yet but should have enough conformation judges for 2019. We may still hire a couple of provisional judges.

Nancy asked about the VISA cards we give for first place in Groups. If you are sponsoring a Group, Carolyn can get the cards and those that are donating can give the money to her prior to the shows.

Candy said last year we also gave hand written cards congratulating the winner of each group. All the groups are now sponsored for VISA cards for first place. Sporting Group is German Shorthaired Pointer Club of Reno Saturday and Cindy Smullen Sunday, Hound Group Cindy Craig both days. Those were the only groups not already covered. VISA cards are \$25.00 each day.

New members:

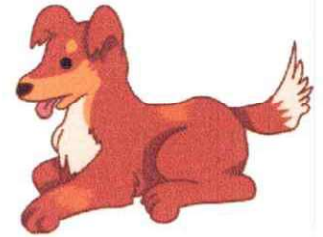
