September 3, 2019 General Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order by President Candy Roper at 7:01 p.m.

Motion by Judy Davis and second by Nancy Hurwitz to approve August 6, 2019 minutes as printed in the August newsletter. Motion passed unanimously to accept minutes as printed in the newsletter.

Secretary reports:

Gail reported approval has been sent for the fall shows and she is getting letters about great volunteers needed for a successful show.

No report from the recording secretary.

Treasurer report:

Lexine Thompson reported beginning balance \$28,165.51 with expenses for monthly website fee and telephone bill for \$162.89. The only income was \$10.00 for membership dues for an ending balance of \$28,012.62. Parks department was just paid which will be a significant amount but will be on next month's report.

Committees

Show:

Candy said we need volunteers for the show. Lex ask if we needed any 4-H volunteers for ring runners and clean up. She will check with the 4-H leader to see if we can get some help from them. Candy will talk with Elaine Oxborrow regarding the person that did clean up last year and if she is not available, we could use the help from 4-H. Kiwanis will do the food Saturday and Sunday. We will need lunch tickets or something so Kiwanis knows who gets food which is only judges and workers. Because of the Board of Health we can't serve the public. Candy wanted to know approximately how many people will need to be fed. The count will probably be between 40-50. Carolyn mentioned getting cakes on Saturday for ring side groups. Carolyn volunteered to take care of the cake.

Thea is offering CGC and Trick Dog at the show.

Sieg said we will need two announcers for the show. We will also need someone to empty garbage cans as they get full. It is an all day chore. We need to make sure the bathrooms get emptied often.

Ring stewards are always needed. Vikki will do it, but only if she has someone helping her. Candy said we will need 4 professional stewards. She will contact Desi Timmerman who's been a steward previously and wants to do it again. Desi has been in Iceland.

Candy has four judges that will need rides. One will be very late at night. Most judges have rides but Candy will send emails to firm up who will need transportation.

Bob's golf cart is out of commission so we need to find one. There was discussion on whether to rent one or finding someone who can donate one for the show.

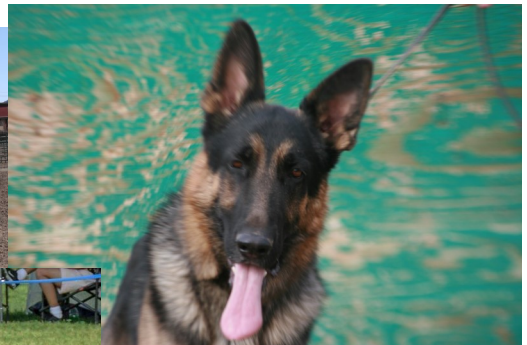
