Payden (Tica Cinema Coastwynd's Reeflections at Aquila PT) was Select bitch at the specialty.

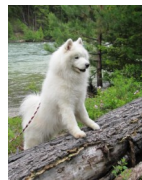
On an awesome note, both Ripley and Payden beat the number one Terv in the country at the specialty.

Mitze Reed's Gen no Miyabi Fujiyamaso (Miya), took Best of Winners both days at the Reno Kennel Club five points each!!

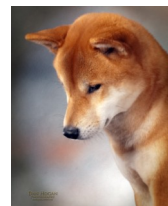


