**Motion Carolyn Goepner, Second by Mitze Reed**, to block off 75 rooms for exhibitors for 2013. Discussion included changing the release date suggested by the Gold Dust West. They will be advertised as the host club's hotel for 2013. **Motion carried** by unanimous vote.

- Sue Altmeier has offered to play the Star Spangled Banner on the bagpipes at our 2013 show.

**Sunshine** - The club received a thanks from Carole Cislaw for the get well card.

**GUESTS:** Joann Brennan, Michele Watson, and Nancy Hurwitz from Carson Canine Adventures introduced themselves. They are interested in having an annual match at their facility. They will also sponsor ring-steward training again. They are adding fly-ball classes.

There will be a workshop to discuss animal regulations on December 12, 2012 from 5:30 to 7:00 p.m. Members were encouraged to attend and wear their club shorts (or a green shirt) to show solidarity. Issues on the agenda include a discussion of the number of dogs per household and breed-specific legislation.

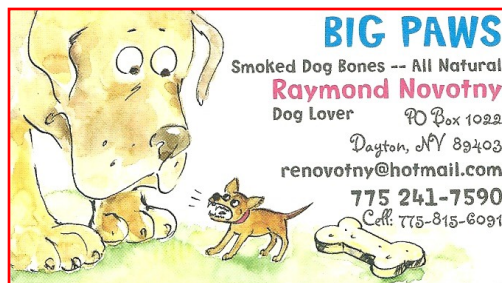
Sieg Goepner thanked everyone for helping at the shows.
