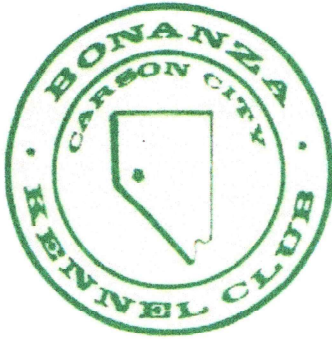

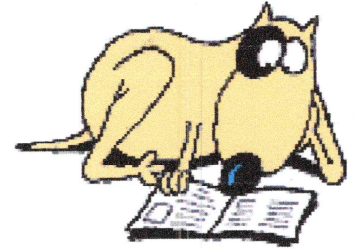

Chris Sage is coming to do the kitchen.

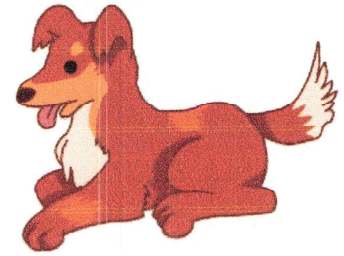
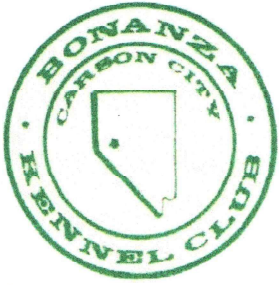
We still need help transporting judges from Reno to Carson City. Lynn McLellan will help. As soon as Candy has itineraries she will know when rides are needed.

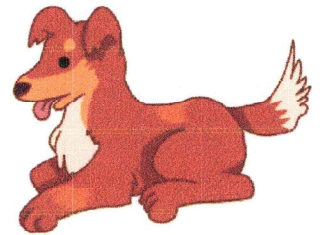

Khezi had some wonderful moments. she did the best she could. Still learning about the "hoops and barrels! " She did great! the Gambles were hard! LOL

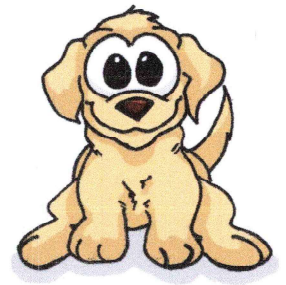

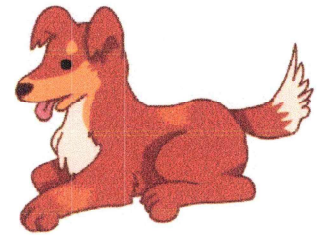
BRAGS:
